PRESIDENT'S REPORT & UPCOMING EVENTS:

- 1. **Auction.** Date: November 3, 2012. Time: 6:30 p.m. 11:00 p.m. Tina Mahoney and Lisa Edwards updated the HSA Board on next year's Auction which will be held at the Bear's Club. The cost will be \$150.00 per person.
- 2. **Benefactor's Party**. *Date: October 6, 2012. Time: TBA.* It will be held at Carolyn Spellman's house, who will underwrite the party. The expected cost will be \$50.00 per couple.
- 3. **Ladies Tea.** Susie Travers and Joy Wilt updated the HSA Board on the outcome of the Ladies Tea. The Committee exceeded its estimations and netted more than 40% of what it expected. The Committee made a net profit of \$20,358.00.
- 4. **Approval of Minutes**. The Minutes of the April 2012 HSA Board Meeting ["Minutes"] were presented. Allie Kleisley moved to approve the Minutes. Michael J. Overbeck seconded the Motion, which passed unanimously.
- 5. Calendar (2012-2013). A copy of the Calendar for School Year 2012-2013 is attached.
- 6. **Magnets.** During the last weeks of this school year, ASCS will allow the students to select certain decorative magnets to take home.
- 7. **Room Cleaning.** Allie Kleisley will set up a clean-up committee to clean the HSA Room.
- 8. **Elections**. This year, the offices of Vice President, Corresponding Secretary, and Member-At-Large were open for election. The officers who currently hold the positions timely applied for reelection. However, no one registered to run for the offices. Thus, the officers were elected without opposition. Therefore, Michael J. Overbeck is the Vice President, Ellen Jones is the Corresponding Secretary, Rosemary Dailey is the HSA Member-At-Large.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Michael J. Overbeck, the Vice President, did not have a report.

PRINCIPAL'S / VICE PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Mrs. Quick advised that the HSA Board meeting room will be moved to Room 109 next year.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Sabra Avery provided the financial update. A copy is attached. At this point, the Eagle Pledge has missed its mark by \$12,071.18, and we are below our goal by \$2,317.78. We are still tying to bring in more Eagle Pledge money to bridge the gap before the end of the year.

Rosemary Dailey moved to increase the HSA activity fee from \$35.00 to \$100.00. Michael J. Overbeck seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Note: After the vote, we were notified that the Pastors met and discussed the increase in the parent activity fee. The Pastors realized the problem. In order to formulate a compromise, the Pastors agreed to reduce the HSA fundraising goal from \$143,000.00 to \$130,000.00 and suggested that we limit the increase from \$35.00 to \$50.00. The HSA Board welcomed the solution and voted by e-mail to reduce the HSA parent activity fee to \$50.00.

Preston J. Fields, Sr. made a motion by e-mail to amend the increased HSA parent activity fee and reduce it from \$100.00 to \$50.00. Michael Overbeck seconded the Motion, which passed unanimously.

PASTOR MODERATOR'S REPORT: FR. DON

Fr. Don updated the Board on the general status of the School. Overall, the School is doing well.

MEMBER AT LARGE REPORT

Rosemary Daily, the Member at Large, reported that there was no further update.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY REPORT

Ellen Jones, the Corresponding Secretary, was not present.

RECORDING SECRETARY

Preston J. Fields, Sr., the Recording Secretary, reported that all Minutes are up to date.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the HSA Board Meeting was adjourned at 10:01 a.m. The next HSA Board Meeting is scheduled for June 4, 2012, at 8:45 a.m. and it will be held in the HSA
