Pre-K and Kindergarten: toothbrushes and toothpaste

1st grade: soap

2nd grade: washcloths

3rd grade: water bottles (must fit in a shoe box)

4th grade: hard candies (individually packaged if possible)

5th grade: small toys (not scary or war related)

6th grade: school supplies

7th grade: combs, brushes, hair accessories

8<sup>th</sup> grade: school supplies

Other items needed: duct tape, poncho, plastic eating utensils, cups, bandages, \$9 to send the boxes
