Dear Middle School Parents and Students,

We are quickly approaching December and the middle school will be giving December exams. Although this is not the middle of the year, we thought it best for students and families not to have to worry or stress over the holiday break about major exams; therefore, we are having December exams. The exams will be on Monday, December 14, Tuesday, December 15 and Wednesday, December 16. There will be make-up exams given on Thursday, December 17, if there is a need for it. Students will sit for 2 exams each morning, have lunch, then attend review classes for the upcoming exams and a specials class in the afternoon. The exams are 1.5 hours long. It is imperative that students are in school the entirety of the day to best prepare for the exams. Below is a schedule of which subject exams will be given on each day by grade. Please refer to it when helping your child plan their study schedule. One week before the exam the teachers will provide the students with review work for their exam.

- Monday- ELA and Spanish
- Tuesday - Math and Religion
- Wednesday - Science and Social Studies

At-Home- Learners (AHLs), will need to take their exams on campus. The school will set up a space for AHLs to take their exams in which all safety measures will be in place. The exams will be done by 11:30 a.m. and the students will be able to be picked up at that time, in front of the school and return home.
