By Elisabeth Hasselbeck

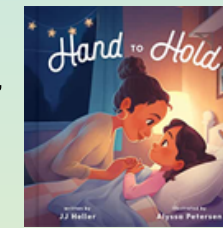

By JJ Heller

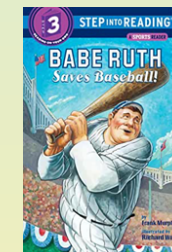
